# New Humanities Building

### Project Description:

The purpose of this project is to add classroom, academic office space, and an enclosed public gathering space to Goldwin Smith Hall and the Arts Quad. This will be the first new building for the Humanities in 100 years. The new space it provides will address the pressing space shortage in the Humanities in general, providing space relief to as many as five buildings on and near the Arts Quad. A 330 seat auditorium on the Atrium level will provide a much needed event forum. The Atrium will provide space for community use including student gatherings, events and productions, as well as daily use for informal study, advising, and dining.

### Project Status:

The Design Development (DD) phase is progressing with a 50% review scheduled for May at which time the budgeted cost will be confirmed through parallel estimates. LeChase Construction Services has been hired to provide pre-construction consulting and estimating.
